YOUR SC BUILDERS PAC AT WORK TOGETHER WE:

➔ **PASSED** the Home Occupancy bill, which provides tax relief on improved property for builders/developers that have new unoccupied homes.

POTENTIAL SAVINGS: More than \$10 million yearly. Plus, it provides an absolute process when improved properties are assessed.

➔ **PASSED** a bill that creates a S.C. Housing Commission within state government that can develop and implement a comprehensive plan to provide more workforce/affordable housing to all citizens of our state.

POTENTIAL SAVINGS: Ultimately millions of dollars will be saved as barriers to affordable housing are diminished.

➔ **ADVOCATED** the adoption of the seismic maps produced specifically for S.C. by the Citadel.

POTENTIAL SAVINGS: More than \$15 million yearly when it is adopted by the S.C. Building Codes Council.

➔ **OPPOSED** a proposed landfill moratorium that would have greatly restricted the use of C&D landfills across South Carolina.

POTENTIAL SAVINGS: \$6 million annually.

➔ **SUPPORTED** a bill that adopted S.C. residential energy standards without causing dramatic and costly changes, which also excluded cap and trade provisions.

POTENTIAL SAVINGS: \$22 million annually.

➔ **PASSED** a bill that would prevent builders from being subjected to frivolous mechanics liens filings, and to keep their credit record clean.

POTENTIAL SAVINGS: \$500,000 annually.
